1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms Regulations, 1976.
2. These Regulations apply —
 - (a) to applications for Firearm Export Permits, Import Permits, User's (General) Licences, (Restricted) Licences, (Special) Permits and Disposal Permits; and
 - (b) to licences and permits granted pursuant to such applications.
3. Applications for licences or permits to which these Regulations apply as well as licences and permits granted shall
 - (a) be in the form specified in the schedule; and
 - (b) contain the particulars therein specified.
4. An applicant for a Firearm User's (Special) Permit must forward with his application two small unmounted photographs, approximately 2 ins x 1½ ins., of himself, and on the back of one such photograph a certificate signed by him that such photograph is a true likeness.
5. No person shall be issued with a —
 - (i) Firearm User's (General) Licence; or
 - (ii) Firearm User's (Restricted) Licence; or
 - (iii) Firearm User's (Special) Permit, unless —
 - (a) in the case of a shot gun, air pistol, air gun or air rifle, he has attained the age of 17 years,
 - (b) in the case of all other types of firearms, he has attained the age of 21 years.
6. An aggrieved applicant may give notice of appeal in the prescribed form which shall be accompanied by a fee of \$2 which will be refunded if the appeal is successful.

Descriptions of Permits Licences Available.

A Firearm Export Permit authorising the holder within such period as is specified therein to export from the Islands to such destination and in such manner such firearm of such type as is therein specified.

A Firearm Import Permit authorising the holder within such period as is specified therein to import a firearm into the Islands from such source as is therein specified.

A Firearm User's (General Licence) authorising the holder subject to the provisions of section 17 of the Firearms Law, to be in possession in the Islands of the firearm specified.

A Firearm User's (Restricted) Licence authorising the holder, subject to the provisions of section 17 of the Firearms Law, to be in possession of the firearm therein specified

- (i) upon premises owned or occupied by the holder and such portion of any public road as passes through such premises; and
- (ii) upon such other premises as are therein specified and such portion of any public road as passes through such premises.

A Firearm User's (Special) Permit authorising the holder to be in possession of the firearm therein specified within any specified area to which the provisions of section 17 of the Firearms Law apply upon such occasions as are therein specified.

A Firearm Disposal Permit authorising the holder thereof to dispose of the firearm therein specified.

N.B. Applicants must use a separate application form for each permit or licence.
