THE JUVENILES LAW, 1975
THE JUVENILES REGULATIONS, 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 31 of the above Law, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Juveniles Regulations 1977.

2. In these Regulations —

"Law" means the Juveniles Law, 1975;

"section" means a section of the Law; and

section 2 applies.

3. As soon as may be convenient after an order has been made to commit a juvenile to the care of a fit person, or approved school, the Court shall record all relevant information in its possession regarding the juvenile.

4. Before any such juvenile is placed in the care of a fit person the Probation Officer shall satisfy himself that the sleeping and living accommodation, health and domestic conditions of the place in which the juvenile will reside are satisfactory and suitable to his particular needs.

5. A fit person shall upon receiving a juvenile into his care be required by the probation officer to sign an agreement in duplicate in the form set out in the schedule. One copy of such agreement shall be retained by the fit person and the other copy shall be kept by the probation officer.

6. The fit person in whose care a juvenile has been placed shall report immediately to the probation officer in case of serious illness, accident to or death of the juvenile in his care.

7. Whenever it is shown to the satisfaction of the court that a fit person in whose care a juvenile has been ordered to be placed is unable to provide for the proper upkeep of the juvenile without financial assistance, and a contribution order has been made by the court under section 22, the court which has made the order may order that the payments thereunder be applied for the upkeep of the juvenile whilst in such care.

8. The notification from the police or any person bringing a juvenile before a court, in terms of section 11(1) shall be in the form set out in the schedule.

9. The report in terms of section 11(2) shall be in the form set out in the schedule.

10. A supervision order under section 14(1)(b) shall be in the form set out in the schedule.

- (c) I will look after his/her health and consult the medical officer whenever the child is ill, and in the event of his/her serious illness or accident I will also notify the probation officer immediately;
- (d) I will provide for the cleaning, mending and renewal of his/her clothing and its proper care;
- (e) I will permit any person authorised by the probation officer to see the child and his/her home and clothing, and I will attend to the advice of any such person;
- (f) I will allow him/her to be removed to any home when required by any person so authorised; and
- (g) I will notify the probation officer within two weeks if I change my address.
