**REGULATIONS, 1976**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by virtue of Sections 51 and 82 of the above Law, the following Regulations are hereby made.

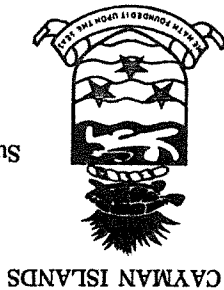
1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1976, and shall come into operation on the second day of February, 1976.

2. The fee prescribed by Regulation 27 for a driving permit for a foreign licensee under Section 35 of the Traffic Law is reduced from \$5 to \$2.40.

(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by virtue of Sections 51, 17 and 82 of the Traffic Law, the following Regulations are hereby made:

Short title.  
1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1976.

2. The Schedule to the Traffic Regulations are hereby amended as follows —

(a) Form T.R. 13 is deleted and the following form is substituted —

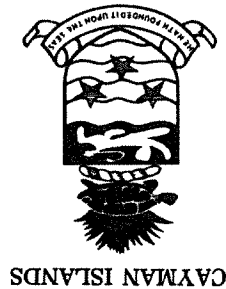
