THE TRAFFIC LAW

(Law 16 of 1973)

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by virtue of sections 77 and 82 of the above Law the following Regulations are hereby made.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1977.
2. The Traffic Regulations are amended as follows —
 - (a) by substituting for the figures "463000" appearing in the third line of paragraph (b) of regulation 22 the figures "463800";
 - (b) by deleting the word "and" at the end of paragraph (a) of regulation 23, adding the word "and" to paragraph (b) thereof and adding a new paragraph (c) as follows —

“(c) the device called the Visual Average Speed Computer and Recorder manufactured by the Federal Sign and Signal Corporation of Blue Island, Illinois, U.S.A., commonly known as VASCAR.”.
 - (c) by amending the second column of form T.R. 21 at page 41 as follows —

substituting 55(i) for 55(j)
55(j) for 55(h)
55(k) for 55(l)
55(l) for 55(m)
55(m) for 55(n)
55(n) for 55(o)
55(o) for 56(1)
68(1)(a) for 68(1)(i)
68(1)(i) for 68(1)(j)
68(1)(j) for 68(1)(k); and

by deleting the existing line —

“Irregular parking — — 68(1)(a) — — \$25”.
