THE PORT AUTHORITY LAW  
(No. 15 of 1976)  
THE PORT (AMENDMENT) (NO. 4)  
REGULATIONS, 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 13 of the Port Authority Law the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Port (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations, 1978. Citation.

2. The Port Regulations are amended as follows — Port Regulations amended.

A. regulation 33 is amended by —

(1) deleting sub-regulation (5) and substituting —

“(5). No power boat, unless engaged in rescue operations, may approach within 200 yards of a ‘divers down’ flag or ‘divers down’ light, and no power boat may exceed a speed of 5 knots when within 200 yards of the shoreline.”;

(ii) substituting in sub-regulation (6) the word “No” for the word “Nor” occurring at the beginning thereof;

B — regulation 109(1) is amended —

(i) in paragraph (d) by inserting between the words “cargo” and “not” in the first line thereof the bracketed words “(including cargo carried by trailers, containers or flat beds)”;

(ii) in the sub-heading following paragraph (d) by deleting the words “Per trailer or container” and substituting “Heavy lift charge”;

(iii) by deleting paragraph (e);

(iv) in paragraph (f) by deleting the word “each” at the end of the fourth line thereof;

C — regulation 124 is hereby revoked;

D — the Schedule (regulation 18) under the heading “Grand Cayman” sub-heading “East End” is amended by substituting for the figure “10” the figure “20”;
