REGULATIONS, 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 13 of the Port Authority Law the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Port (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulations, 1978.

2. Regulation 105 of the Port Regulations is hereby amended by revoking subregulation (5) thereof and substituting the following two new subregulations thereof —

“(5) The following vessels, that is to say —

- (a) locally-owned fishing vessels;
- (b) locally-owned pleasure vessels;
- (c) vessels belonging to Her Majesty;
- (d) vessels belonging to the Government;
- (e) vessels belonging to the government of any nation,

are exempt from port dues.

(6) Pleasure vessels which are not locally owned are exempted from all port dues other than berthing charges under regulations 104 and 105:

Provided, that the Director may waive such charges where the vessel concerned is not carrying passengers for reward and, in the opinion of the Director, berths for no longer than is necessary to load or discharge passengers or crew members.”
