In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 7 (h) of the above Law the following Regulations are hereby made.

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum Handling and Transportation (Licensing) Regulations.

Forms.

- 2. The form of application for a licence under these Regulations and the form of licence are prescribed in the Schedule.
- Terms of licenses.

3. The acceptance of a licence under these Regulations operates as a binding obligation upon the licensee to the Government of the Cayman Islands to comply with all the terms of the above Law and all Regulations made thereunder having application to the business of the licensee and such obligation operates independently of any penal clauses in the above Law and Regulations contained.
