holds a licence under this Law, such revocation shall, ipso facto, revoke such last-mentioned licence. No refund of any licence fee shall be payable as the result of such revocation.".



A LAW to amend the Trade and Business Licensing Law (Revised)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade and Business Licensing (Amendment) Law, 1979.

Section 8 of the Business Licensing Law (Revised) amended.

2. Subsection (1) of section 8 of the Trade and Business Licensing Law (Revised) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) is amended by substituting for the words "fifteen" and "thirty-one", where they appear therein, the words "thirty" and "ninety" respectively.

Addition of new section 11A to the principal Law.

3. The principal Law is hereby amended by inserting, immediately following section 11 thereof, the following new section —

"Revocation of 11A. In the event of the revocation under the Local Companies (Control) Law (Revised) of a licence under that Law authorising the holder thereof to carry on any trade or business in respect of which he also
