**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC LAW
(REVISED) AND THE TRAFFIC LAW, 1991**

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title and
commencement.

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic Laws (Amendment) Law, 1993 and shall come into force on the 6th day of December, 1993.

Amendments to
the Traffic Law
(Revised).

2. (1) Section 2 of the Traffic Law (Revised) is amended by repealing the definition of "omnibus" and substituting the following definition -

"omnibus" means a vehicle constructed, or capable of being used, for the carriage of more than nine persons excluding the driver and which is licensed for the carriage of passengers whether upon a casual fare paying basis or by private arrangement;".

(2) The Traffic Law (Revised) is amended -

(a) by inserting in section 11, after the words "the licensing authority on being satisfied that the application is in order shall", the words ", subject to section 11A,";

(b) by inserting after section 11 the following new section -

" Direction for
registration.

11A. The Licensing Authority shall not register any motor vehicle which is constructed, or capable of being used, for the carriage of more than nine persons excluding the driver unless it has received a direction from the Governor authorising that registration."

(3) Section 12A of the Traffic Law (Revised) is repealed and the following section substituted -

" Importation and
use of vehicles.

12A (1) Unless he has received the prior permission of the Governor, a person shall not import into or use in the Islands any motor vehicle which is constructed, or capable of being used, for the carriage of more than nine persons excluding the driver.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000."

Amendments to
the Traffic Law,
1991.

3. (1) The definition of "omnibus" in Section 2 of the Traffic Law, 1991 is amended by repealing the words "motor vehicle constructed and used" and substituting the words "motor vehicle constructed, or capable of being used,".

(2) Section 11 of the Traffic Law, 1991 is amended by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection -

"(2A) Unless he has received the prior permission of the Governor, a person shall not import into or use in the Islands any motor vehicle which is constructed, or capable of being used, for the carriage of more than nine persons excluding to the driver."

(3) Section 21 of the Traffic Law, 1991 is amended by inserting after paragraph (d) the following paragraph -

"(dd) the vehicles or categories of vehicles which may be registered and the conditions subject to which any vehicle or category of vehicle may be registered."

Passed by the Legislative Assembly the 3rd day of December, 1993.
