- (2) The power to make regulations under this section includes power to make such supplementary, incidental, consequential or transitional provisions as the Governor considers necessary or expedient."

A LAW TO AMEND
THE MENTAL HEALTH LAW, 1979

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Mental Health (Amendment) Law, 1994.

Amendment of the
Mental Health Law,
1979.

2. The Mental Health Law, 1979, is amended by repealing section 15 and substituting the following --

" Regulations.

15. (1) The Governor may by regulations --

(a) prescribe any place which the Chief Medical Officer certifies is appropriate (in all the circumstances) to receive and care for a mentally disordered person as a place of safety for the purposes of this Law; and
