A LAW TO AMEND THE PRISONS LAW; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Law, 1998.

2. In this Law "the principal Law" means the Prisons Law.

3. Section 2 of the principal Law is amended by the repeal of the definition of "corporal punishment".

4. Section 36 of the principal Law is amended by repealing "may, in addition to any other punishment imposed by law, be ordered by the court of trial to undergo corporal punishment and".

5. Section 40 of the principal Law is amended by repealing paragraph (c).
