

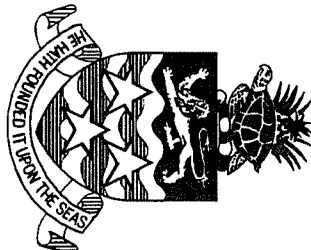
“(3) If an account for the supply of water to premises is transferred to a new account holder without the physical disconnection and reconnection of the supply of water, a new account fee of \$25 shall be paid by the new account holder before the transfer is effected.”

THE WATER AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) (SEWERAGE CHARGES AND RECONNECTION FEES) REGULATIONS, 1998



The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 70 of the Water Authority Law (1996 Revision), makes the following Regulations-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Authority (Amendment) (Sewerage Charges and Reconnection Fees) Regulations, 1998. Citation

2. In these Regulations, "the principal Regulations" means the Water Authority Regulations (1997 Revision). Interpretation

3. Regulation 45 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (2) by inserting at the end the following- Sewerage charges

"Schools, colleges and technical training facilities 0.0375 per sq. ft. of classroom area

Public swimming pools, public sports stadia and public parks 20 per toilet, plus 50 per urinal, plus 20 per wash basin".



4. Regulation 50 of the principal Regulations is amended-

(a) in subregulation (2) by repealing the words "shall be paid equal to the charge mentioned in subregulation (1) plus fifteen per cent before the supply of water is reconnected", and substituting the following-

"of \$25 shall be paid before the supply of water is reconnected.";

and

(b) by inserting, after subregulation (2), the following subregulation-
