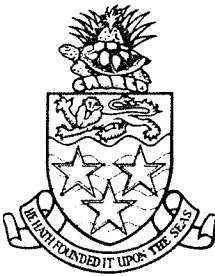

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prescribe forms for traffic tickets issued by constables under section 79 of the Traffic Law, 1991, in respect of traffic ticket offences. The Regulations also prescribe the fines for these traffic ticket offences. The procedure for payment of these fines, and the court proceedings for non-payment of the fines, are described in sections 78 to 82 of the Traffic Law, 1991.

THE TRAFFIC TICKET REGULATIONS 1996

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92 of the Traffic Law, 1991, makes the following Regulations :—

Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Ticket Regulations 1996.

Traffic Tickets and Fines

2. (1) For the purposes of section 79 of the Traffic Law, 1991, the prescribed forms of traffic tickets are the forms set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations.

(2) For the purposes of section 79 of the Traffic Law, 1991, the prescribed fines for the offences referred to in that section are the fines in the last column of the table in Schedule 2 to these Regulations specified respectively for the offences listed in the first column of that table.
