THE TRAFFIC (RADAR EQUIPMENT) REGULATIONS 1996

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92 of the Traffic Law, 1991, makes the following Regulations —

Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Radar Equipment) Regulations, 1996.

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of these Regulations a radar speed measuring device includes the radar speed meters and the radar speedometers prescribed by these Regulations.

Radar speed measuring devices

- 3. For the purposes of section 77 of the Traffic Law 1991, the following are prescribed speed measuring devices
 - (a) the Genesis I radar speed measuring device manufactured by Decatur Electronics Inc. of Decatur, Illinois, United States of America, and
 - (b) the Speedgun Magnum radar speed measuring device manufactured by CMI Inc., a subsidiary of MPD Inc. of Owensboro, Kentucky, United States of America.
