**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAVEL TAX LAW TO REDUCE THE
CATEGORIES OF PERSONS WHO ARE ENTITLED TO EXEMPTIONS
UNDER THE TRAVEL TAX LAW (1995 REVISION); AND FOR
INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Travel Tax (Amendment) Law, 1999.
2. The Travel Tax Law (1995 Revision) is amended in section 2 by repealing the definition of “traveller” and substituting the following-

1995 Revision

“traveller” means a person other than-

- (a) a member of the crew of an aircraft being carried on the aircraft for the sole purpose of taking part in the provision of services on the aircraft;
- (b) a diplomat; or
- (c) a child under 12 years of age.”.
