A LAW TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN  
EXPENDITURE DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1990

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short Title.	1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1990) Law, 1992.
Expenditure Confirmed. (Law 21 of 1989)	2. The expenditure during the financial year ending 31 December, 1990, in the amount of \$13,857,179 on services set forth in the Schedule and not provided by the Appropriation (1990) Law, 1989, is allowed and confirmed.
