THE MARINE CONSERVATION (AMENDMENT) (SPEAR GUN FEES)
REGULATIONS, 2001

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Marine Conservation Law (1995 Revision), the Governor makes the following regulations -

1. These regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Amendment) (Spear Gun Fees) Regulations, 2001.

Citation
2. The Marine Conservation Regulations (1996 Revision), are amended in Form MC 12 in the Fourth Schedule by repealing the paragraph commencing with the words “Please complete” and ending with the words “Treasury Department.” and by substituting the following paragraph -

“Please complete this application in full. It will be considered by the Marine Conservation Board at the first meeting possible. If approved, you will be notified by the Department of Environment and may collect your licence from the Department after paying the appropriate fee.”.

Amendment of the Fourth Schedule of the Marine Conservation Regulations (1996 Revision) - forms
3. The Marine Conservation Regulations (1996 Revision) are amended in the Fifth Schedule, in the item “Speargun licence under section 14”, by repealing “\$25” and substituting “\$50”.
