| 1. This Law may be cited as the Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) (Amendment) (Variation of Fees) Law, 2001. | Short title. |
| 2. The Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) Law (2000 Revision) is amended in section 4(a) by repealing the words “eight dollars” and substituting the words “sixteen dollars”. | Amendment of section 4 of the Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) Law (2000 Revision) - duty of agents |
| 3. The Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) Law (2000 Revision) is amended in section 6 by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection -

“(1) Every agent shall collect -
(a) from every passenger in every outward bound vessel, an environmental protection fee of two dollars; and
(b) from every passenger in every outward bound aircraft, an environmental protection fee of four dollars,
