THE MERCHANT SHIPPING LAW (2001 REVISION)

THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (FEES) REGULATIONS, 2002

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 455(1) and (2) of the Merchant Shipping Law (2001 Revision), makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Fees) Citation Regulations, 2002.

2. In these Regulations-

Interpretation

"annual tonnage fee" means an annual payment, calculated on the gross tonnage of the ship as set out in the Schedule;

"authorised person" means an appropriately qualified and experienced surveyor or inspector authorised by the Director to undertake surveys or inspections and similar work on behalf of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry;

"chargeable time" means the total time expended by one or more officials of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry in conducting a survey or providing a service which has either been requested, or is required under the Law:

"Classification Society" means a body engaged in the survey and classification of ships with respect to their design and structural standards;

"fees" means the fees set out in the Schedule:

"gross tonnage" means the gross tonnage or gross tons as shown on the ship's tonnage certificate; save that, for the purpose of these Regulations-

- (a) where a ship claims a lower gross tonnage with respect to the application of safety requirements to that ship, such lower gross tonnage shall not be used for calculating the fees payable; and
- (b) where a ship is assigned only one tonnage, that tonnage shall be taken as its gross tonnage for calculating fees payable;

"LL" means, for the purposes of these Regulations, "Length" as defined in the International Convention on Load Lines, 1966, as amended;

"out of pocket expenses" includes any cost incurred in respect of conducting a survey or providing a service other than chargeable time or a set fee;

"recognised organisation" means a body authorised by the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry to undertake surveys and related work and to issue statutory certificates on behalf of the Cayman Islands Government and includes any of the Classification Societies for the time being so authorised for this purpose;

"services" means the services contained in the Schedule and any other similar service required under the Law; and

"TL" means, for the purposes of these Regulations, "Length" as defined in the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969, as amended.

Application and level of fees

- 3. (1) The fees payable for the surveys or services specified in the Schedule shall be the fees specified in relation thereto in the Schedule.
- (2) The fees in these Regulations apply with respect to any of the surveys or services in the Schedule which are provided by or on behalf of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry with respect to-
 - (a) Cayman Islands ships or their owners or operators;
 - (b) any seafarer serving or intending to serve on board a Cayman Islands ship; and
 - (c) any other vessel, or its owner or operator, or any other seafarer, where a service has been provided by request or has been rendered under the Law.
- (3) The fees referred to in this regulation shall be payable by the person to whom the service was provided, or on his behalf by some other person, at the discretion of the Director.

Application and payment of annual tonnage fee

- 4. (1) The owner of every Cayman Islands ship shall, on or before the 31st day of January in each year, pay to the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry the annual tonnage fee set out in the Schedule, as payment in advance of the tonnage fee due for that year.
- (2) Where the fee due has not been paid by the 1st day of March in the year in which due, a 10% surcharge may be levied, and if the fees remain unpaid beyond the 1st day of May a further 5% surcharge may be levied for each month or part month thereafter for which the fee remains unpaid.

Determination of fees due

- 5. (1) Where a fee is determined by the amount of work involved, the following shall be taken into account when calculating the charges incurred-
 - (a) for work involving a visit out of the office to a ship or shore establishment, charges shall include-
 - (i) the time spent conducting the service, charged at the relevant hourly rate specified in the Schedule, such time to include both in office and out of office time;
 - (ii) travelling time between the office and a ship or shore establishment, charged at the relevant hourly rate specified in the Schedule, subject to a maximum charge of 16 hours for any one visit;

- (iii) time spent in local travel to and from a ship or shore establishment may be included in addition to the travelling time in sub subparagraph (i);
- (iv) the cost of transport to and from the ship or shore establishment and any costs incidental thereto;
- (v) the cost of accommodation and subsistence for the persons providing the service or survey;
- (vi) any additional costs incurred in relation to the work involved, including out of pocket expenses; and
- (b) for work undertaken not involving a visit to a ship or shore establishment, charges shall include-
 - (i) the time spent conducting the service, charged at the relevant hourly rate specified in the Schedule; and
 - (ii) out of pocket expenses.
- (2) Time shall be charged to the nearest tenth of an hour.
- (1) Subject to paragraph (2), payment of fees and charges are to be made-

Fees and charges to be paid in advance

- (a) in advance of the survey being conducted or service being provided where the amount is pre-determinable; or
- (b) where it is not possible to pre-determine the precise amount payable, then a deposit, the amount of which is to be assessed by the Director, shall be made in advance of the survey or service being commenced, pending the final determination of the total amount payable.
- (2) Monies held on deposit shall be refundable less all accrued charges.
- (3) The Director may, in appropriate circumstances, waive the requirement for fees and charges or a deposit against fees and charges, to be paid in advance.
- 7. (1) In the case of a survey conducted or a service provided by or on behalf Additional charges for of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry for which a fixed fee is payable, an additional charge may be levied where the chargeable time expended becomes excessive.

- (2) For the purpose of this regulation, where the chargeable time actually spent in conducting a survey or providing a service, multiplied by the appropriate hourly rate or rates, exceeds 150% of the applicable fixed fee, then the time expended shall be deemed to be excessive.
- (3) The additional charge which may be levied is to be calculated by subtracting 150% of the applicable fixed fee from the product of the chargeable time and the appropriate hourly rate or rates.

(4) The Director may, at his discretion, waive the additional charge for excessive work depending on the facts and circumstances of the case.

Provision of survey or service by recognised organisation

8. Where a recognised organisation has been authorised to conduct a survey or provide a service to a ship or person on behalf of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry and the recognised organisation applies its own fees for such survey or service, then fees under these Regulations for that survey or service shall not apply, except with respect to additional work carried out by the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry in respect to the survey conducted or service provided by the recognised organisation.

Provision of survey or service by authorised person other than a recognised organisation 9. Where an authorised person conducts a survey or provides a service to a ship or person on behalf of the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry and the fees specified in these Regulations apply, the fees payable to the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry may, at the discretion of the Director, be reduced to a level consistent with associated work carried out by the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry in respect to the survey conducted or service provided by the authorised person.

Adjustment of fees and charges in certain cases

10. Where the Schedule does not specifically provide for a variation of fees, the Director may, with the authorisation of the Minister, apply a variation or alternate means of calculating and applying fees if the circumstances so warrant.

Certificates and documents may be withheld if payment of fees not made 11. Where a fee is payable under these Regulations for the issue or endorsement of a certificate, the certificate or endorsement may be withheld until the fee has been paid.

Surcharges for late payment

- 12. Where fees and charges, other than the annual tonnage fee, remain unpaid beyond 60 days from the date of issue of the applicable invoice, the following surcharges may be levied and added to the invoiced amount-
 - (a) 10% of the amount outstanding where payment is made within 30 days following the 60 day initial period referred to above; and
 - (b) 5% of the amount outstanding for each additional period or part period of 30 days for which the fees and charges remain unpaid.

Fees and charges for survey or service not in the Schedule

- 13. (1) Where a survey or service not specified in the Schedule is conducted or provided by the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry on request or in accordance with the law relating to merchant shipping, the fees for such a survey or service may be charged at the appropriate hourly rate and in accordance with regulation 5.
- (2) The Director may fix the charges for publications and other material not specified in the Schedule.

15. Fees in any amount and of any kind referred to in these Regulations which Fees paid prior to were paid prior to the coming into force of these Regulations shall be deemed to have been paid in accordance with these Regulations.

Regulations coming into

16. Costs incurred by the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry in respect of casualty and other inquiries and investigations, as well as judicial and administrative proceedings, are recoverable as charges from the parties who are the subjects of the inquiries, investigations or proceedings, as the case may be, and the relevant provisions of these Regulations shall apply in the same manner as they apply to other charges.
