**A LAW TO AMEND THE NATIONAL DRUG COUNCIL LAW (2001
REVISION) TO RE-DESIGNATE THE RELEVANT MINISTER FOR
THE PURPOSES OF THE LAW**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the National Drug Council (Amendment) Law, 2002. Short title

2. The National Drug Council Law (2001 Revision) is amended in section 2 by repealing the definition of the term “Minister” and substituting the following definition - Amendment of section 2 of the National Drug Council Law (2001 Revision) - definitions

“ “Minister” means the member of the Executive Council for the time being charged with responsibility for the subject matter of this Law;”.
