**A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS LAW  
(SECOND REVISION)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1984.

Amendment of s. 9.

2. The Customs Law (Second Revision) in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by substituting the following for paragraph (e) of section 9 —

“(e) to arrest without warrant any person contravening or suspected of having contravened any provision of sections 50, 51, 52, 53 or 54 of this Law:

PROVIDED that any person arrested under this paragraph shall as soon as practicable be handed over by him to a constable or taken by him to a police station;”.

Amendment of s. 21.

3. Section 21 of the principal Law is amended by revoking subsection (4).

Amendment of s. 22.

4. Section 22 of the principal Law is amended, in subsection (1), by -

(a) the deletion of “; or” at the end of paragraph (d) thereof and the substitution therefor of a fullstop; and

(b) the deletion of paragraph (e).
