In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 2 and by paragraph (c) of section 73 of this Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) Regulations, 1986.

Prescription of Warehouse.

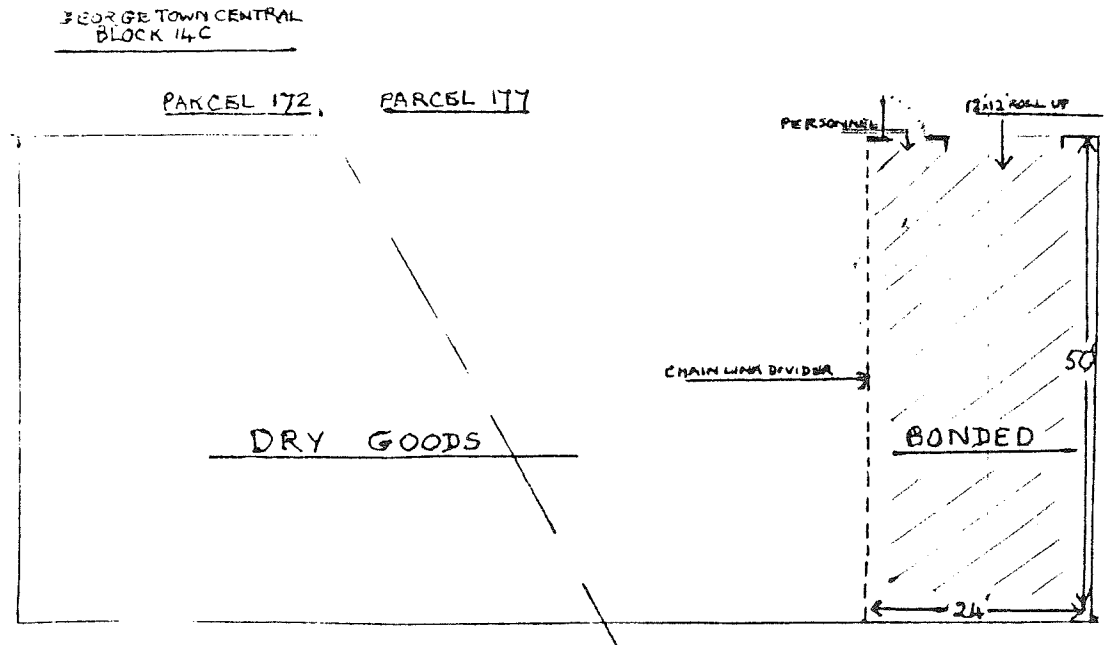
2. Subject to the conditions prescribed in the Second Schedule, the building described in the First Schedule is prescribed to be a warehouse for the purposes of the Law.

Nomination of Warehouse Keeper.

3. For the purposes of the Law, the person named in the Third Schedule is nominated to be warehouse keeper of the warehouse prescribed in regulation 2.

**FIRST SCHEDULE**

That portion of the building shaded in the floor-plan depicted hereunder, being a part of the Jacques Scott compound situated in Crewe Road at George Town know as Registration Section George Town Central Block 14C Parcels 172 and 177.



SECOND SCHEDULE

No goods other than those of Jacques Scott and Company Limited or any of its wholly-owned subsidiaries or any of their respective customers shall be stored in the warehouse.
