A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS LAW (SECOND REVISION)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1986.

Amendment of s. 44.

- 2. Section 44 of the Customs Law (Second Revision) is amended -
 - (a) by substituting a colon for the semicolon at the end of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) and by adding the following proviso immediately thereafter "Provided that this paragraph does not apply to any spirits and wines sold at an airport or port where a bonded duty-free shop system is operated; and";
 - (b) by adding the following new subsection "(4) In subsection (1), "bonded duty-free shop" means a retail outlet prescribed by the Governor at a departure lounge or other place controlled by Customs at a port or airport."
