THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1987**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of section 9 and by paragraph (c) of section 73 of this Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1987.

Insertion of new reg. 2A.

2. The Customs Regulations (Revised), in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended by inserting the following new regulation immediately after regulation 2 -

“Prescribed search
warrant.

2A. For the purposes
of sub-paragraph (ii)
of paragraph (a) of

section 9, the prescribed warrant of search is set out in Form E in Part I of the Schedule.”

Amendment of Schedule.

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by inserting the following new form immediately after Form D in Part I -

WHEREAS I/the court am/is satisfied by information on oath that there is reasonable suspicion of the commission of the following offence against the Customs Law (Second Revision) viz and it has been made to appear to this court/me that it is essential to the

inquiry into the said offence that a place, premises, person or thing
be entered and searched.

This is to authorise and require you to enter and search (as the case
may be) the following place, premises, person or thing viz
situate at

, returning this
warrant with an endorsement certifying the manner of execution.
