THE CUSTOMS LAW (SECOND REVISION) THE CUSTOMS (PRESCRIBED WAREHOUSE) REGULATIONS, 1987

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 2 and by paragraph (c) of section 73 of this Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) Regulations, 1987.

Prescription of warehouse.

2. Subject to the conditions prescribed in the Second Schedule, the premises described in the First Schedule are prescribed to be a warehouse for the purposes of the Law.

Nomination of warehouse keeper.

3. For the purposes of the Law, the person named in the Third Schedule is nominated to be warehouse keeper of the warehouse prescribed in regulation 2.
