THE CUSTOMS LAW (SECOND REVISION) THE CUSTOMS (PRESCRIBED WAREHOUSE) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1987

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 2 and by paragraph (c) of section 73 of this Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) (No. 2) Regulations, 1987.
- 2. Subject to the conditions prescribed in the Second Schedule, the premises described in the First Schedule are prescribed to be a warehouse for the purpose of the Law.
- 3. For the purposes of the Law, the person named in the Third Schedule is nominated to be warehouse keeper of the warehouse prescribed in regulation 2.


FIRST SCHEDULE
