CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE) (SHELLECTIONS) REGULATIONS 1992

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 73 of the Customs Law, 1990, the following regulations are made –

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (ShellectionS) Regulations 1992.

Prescription of warehouse.


2. Subject to compliance with the conditions set out in Schedule 2, the part of the building described in Schedule 1 that is shown hatched on the plan set out in that Schedule is a bonded warehouse.

Warehouse keeper.

3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper in respect of the bonded warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

SCHEDULE 1 The Bonded Warehouse

That part of the building situated on Bodden Avenue at George Town known as Registration Section George Town Central Block 13EH Parcel 127 that is shown hatched on the following plan.



SCHEDULE 2

Conditions to be Complied With

- 1. That a bond is entered into and maintained in the sum of \$25,000.00 with a recognised bank as security to cover the duty risk in respect of goods from time to time in the bonded warehouse.
- 2. That no goods, other than those the property of ShellectionS Ltd. be stored in the bonded warehouse.
