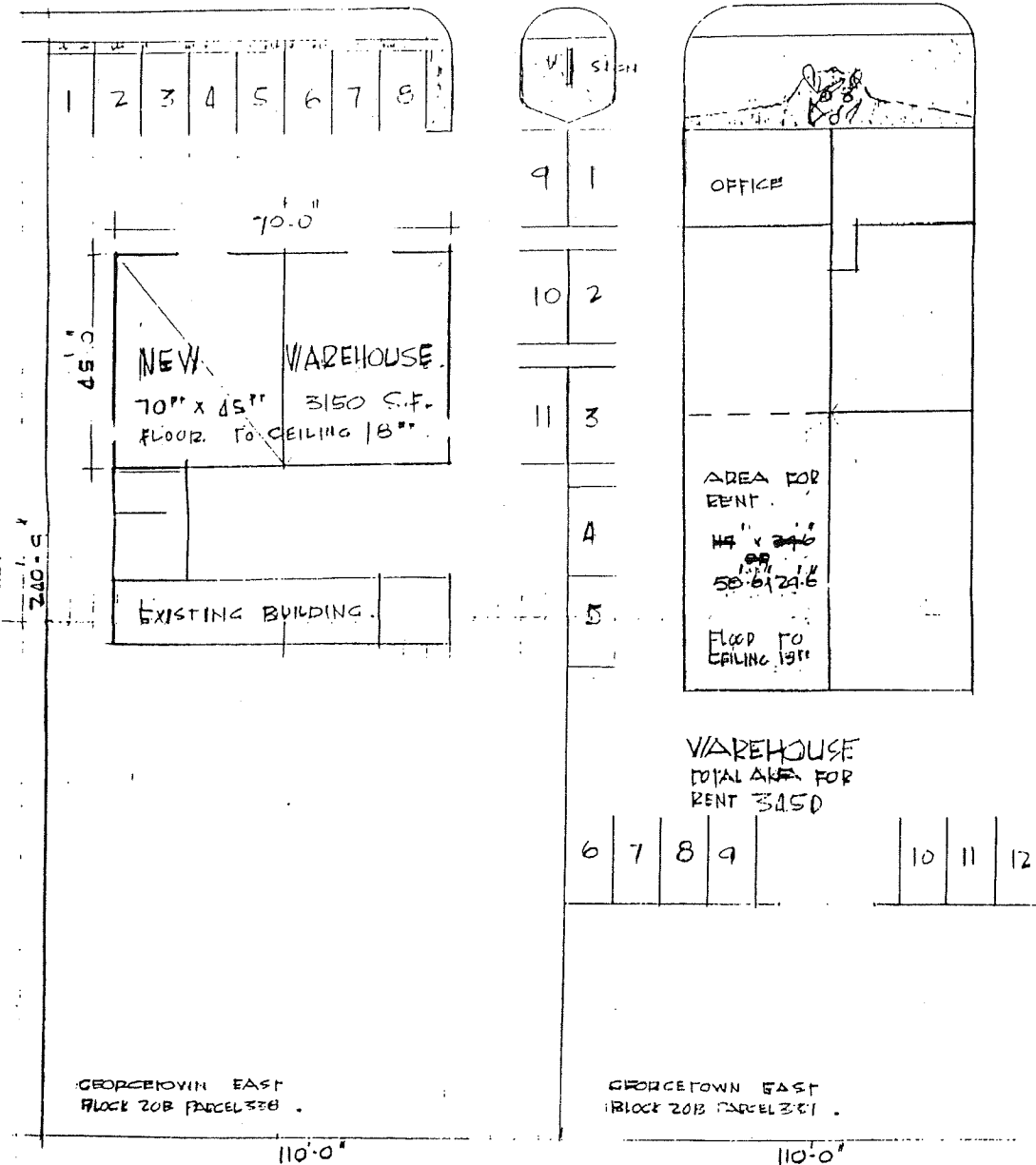
In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 73 of the Customs Law 1990, the following regulations are made –

| Citation                  | 1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) Tortuga Rum Co. Ltd. Regulations 1995.                               |
| Prescription of warehouse | 2. Subject to compliance with the conditions set out in Schedule 2, the area described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse.              |
| Warehouse Keeper          | 3. The person named in Schedule 3 will continue to be the warehouse keeper in respect of the bonded warehouse referred to in Schedule 2. |

# SCHEDULE 1

## The Bonded Warehouse

That area shaded on the following floor plan being part of the building situated in the Industrial Park Area and constructed on the land known as Registration Section George Town East, Block 20B, Parcel 337.



## **SCHEDULE 2**

### **Conditions to be complied with**

1. An additional bond in the sum of CI\$90,000 to be obtained with a recognised bank as security to cover the duty risk in respect of goods from time to time kept in the bonded warehouse.
2. That no goods, other than alcoholic beverages and tobacco products, the property of Tortuga Rum Co. Ltd., be stored in the bonded warehouse.
