## THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1990

## THE CUSTOMS (PROHIBITED IMPORTS) ORDER 1996

The Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 10(1)(d) of the Customs Law, 1990, makes the following order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Order 1996.
- 2. The import of bows, catapults or other manually operated weapons which are capable of projecting arrows or other missiles is absolutely prohibited except that such objects may be imported, when accompanied by a permit signed by the Commissioner of Police, by a natural person in connection with his competitive sporting activities or the carrying on by him of activities relating to the cultural or historical aspects of weapons.
