## **THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1990**

### **THE CUSTOMS (GAYISLE ENTERPRISES LIMITED) REGULATIONS 1996**

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 73 of the Customs Law, 1990, makes the following regulations –

#### **Title**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Gayisle Enterprises Limited) Regulations 1996.

#### **Prescribed warehouse**

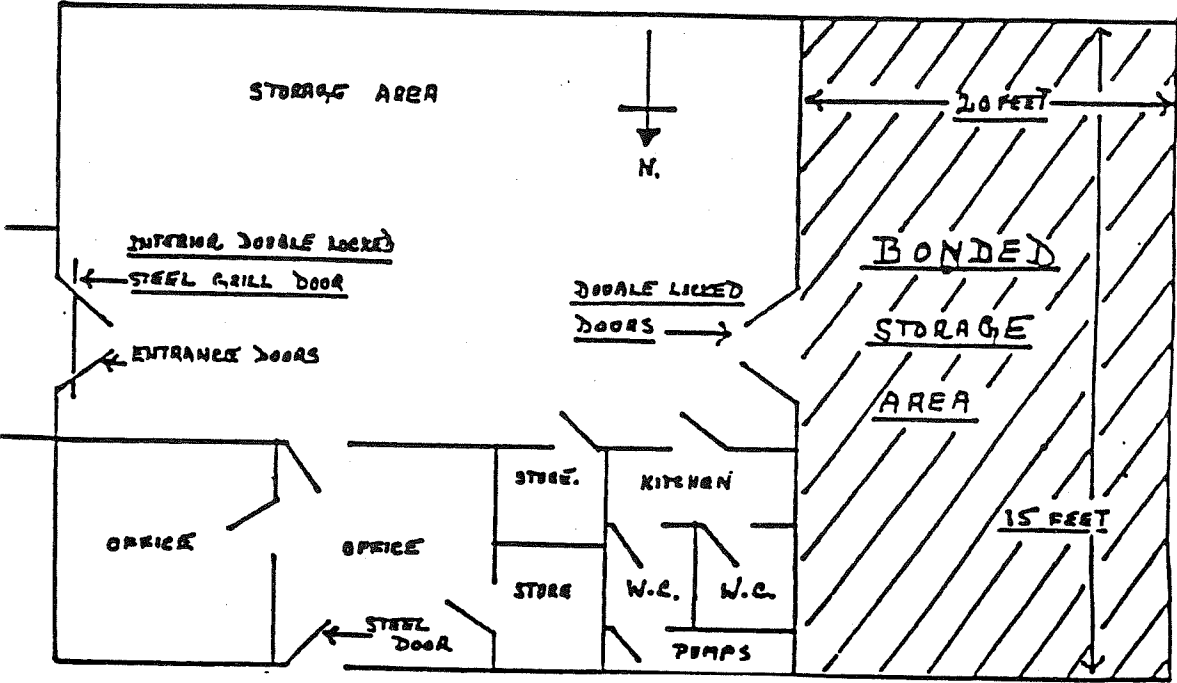
2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the area described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse.

#### **Warehousekeeper**

3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be a warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

**SCHEDULE 1**

That part of the building shaded in the floor plan depicted hereunder located at the Airport Industrial Park on property described as Block 20B Parcel 209 George Town East being part of the building known as Gayisle Enterprises Limited.



**SCHEDULE 2**

No goods other than those of Gayisle Enterprises Limited or any of their customers shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.

**SCHEDULE 3**

**Warehouse Keeper**
