THE CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE) (UNCLE BILL'S HOME IMPROVEMENT CENTRE) REGULATIONS, 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 73 of the Customs Law (1997 Revision) the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) Short title (Uncle Bill's Home Improvement Centre) Regulations, 1997.
- 2. The premises described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse for the storage Prescribed warehouse of cigarettes.
- 3. The person named in Schedule 2 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

SCHEDULE 1

The Bonded Warehouse

That part of the building located in Eastern Avenue, George Town, Block 13EH, Parcels 146 and 147, consisting of an area of 60 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for approval of a bonded warehouse made by William H McTaggart dated 14 March, 1997.
