**CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE)  
(TORTUGA RUM CO.) REGULATIONS, 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 73 of the Customs Law (1998 Revision) the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Tortuga Rum Co.) Regulations, 1999. Short title
2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the premises described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse. Prescribed warehouse
3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2. Warehouse keeper
4. The Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Natural Products Importing Co. Ltd.) Regulations 1996 are repealed. Repeal of Regulations

**SCHEDULE 1**

**The Bonded Warehouse**

That part of the building located at North Sound Road, Block 14C, Parcel 280, Georgetown Central section consisting of an area of 750 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for approval of a bonded warehouse made by David Berry on 21st March, 1995.

**SCHEDULE 2**

**Conditions**

1. That a bond in the sum of \$100,000 with a recognised bank or insurance company be taken out to cover the duty risk in respect of goods in the bonded warehouse at any time.

2. That no goods, other than spirits the property of Tortuga Rum Co. be stored in the bonded warehouse.
