**CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE)
(CAYMAN AIRWAYS LTD.) REGULATIONS, 2000**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 73 of the Customs Law (1998 Revision) the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Cayman Airways Ltd.) Regulations, 2000. Short title
2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the premises described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse. Prescribed warehouse
3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2. Warehouse keeper
4. The Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) Regulations, 1990 are repealed. Repeal of the Customs
(Prescribed Warehouse)
Regulations, 1990

SCHEDULE 1

The Bonded Warehouse

That part of the building located at the Terminal Building, Owen Roberts Airport, Block 20C, Parcel 25, Georgetown consisting of an area of 93.5 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the request for a change in the area of the bonded warehouse made by Rickey Bodden on March 2, 2000.

SCHEDULE 2

Conditions

That no goods, other than those for in-flight consumption by passengers flying with Cayman Airways Limited, shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.
