A LAW TO FURTHER VARY DUTIES UNDER THE CUSTOMS TARIFF LAW (2001 REVISION)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) (Further Short title. Variation of Duties) Law, 2001.

2. The Customs Tariff Law (2001 Revision) is amended in section 2 by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection –

Amendment of section 2 of the Customs Tariff Law (2001 Revision) definitions

(1A) In code number 27.03 in the First Schedule -

"electricity" means electric current or energy or any like agency; and

"undertaker" means a person in contractual relationship with the Governor in Council for the purpose of generating electricity and supplying it to the public for reward.".

3. The Customs Tariff Law (2001 Revision) is amended in the First Schedule in the column headed "Duty"-

Amendment of First Schedule to the Customs Tariff Law (2001 Revision) - duties of customs on imports

- (a) opposite code number 27.01 by repealing "40 cents per gallon" and substituting "50 cents per gallon";
- (b) by repealing the item under code number 27.02 and substituting the following -

The Customs Tariff (Amendment) (Further Variation of Duties) Law, 2001

'27.02 Diesel oil excluding diesel oil under 60 cents Code Number 27.03 per gallon";

and

(c) by inserting below code number 27.02 the following code number and item -

"27.03 Diesel oil imported for supply to an undertaker 50 cents per gallon".
