A LAW TO AMEND THE DEFAMATION LAW (REVISED) (LAW 27 OF 1966)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Defamation (Amendment) Law, 1985.

Amendment of s.2 of Law 27 of 1966.

- 2. Section 2 of the Defamation Law (Revised) (hereinafter called the "principal law") is amended by the addition, in its correct alphabetical order, of the following new definition
 - "broadcasting station" means a station duly licensed under the provisions of the Broadcasting Law, 1977, or wholly owned by the Government of the Cayman Islands;".

Amendment of s.13 of the principal Law.

3. Section 13 of the principal Law is amended by the addition, immediately following the word "newspaper" where the word firstly occurs, of the words "or by any broadcasting station" and is further amended in the first proviso thereto by the addition of the words, immediately following the word "newspaper", of the words "or by the broadcasting station".
