DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1993

The Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35 (1) of the Development and Planning Law (Revised), makes the following Regulations, a draft of which has been approved by resolution of the Legislative Assembly —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Development and Planning (Amendment) Regulations 1993.

Amendment to regulation 7

2 Regulation 7(2) of the Development and Planning Regulations, 1977 ("the principal Regulations") is amended by inserting after the words "or in residential zones, two storeys." the words "Provided that in a Beach Resort/Residential zone the maximum permitted height of a building is 33 feet to the soffits of the eaves, or three storeys, whichever is the less.".

Amendment to regulation 13

3. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting, after the word "requirements", the words "(other than for the height of buildings)".
