NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 6(2)

In exercise of its powers under paragraph (2) of regulation 6 of the Species Bred in Captivity or Artificialy Propagated (Forms and Procedures) Regulations, 1982, the Governor in Council hereby stipulates that the particulars needed to be set forth in an application for certification under paragraph (1) of regulation 6 in respect of all turtles and/or derivatives bred in captivity are —

- 1. Name and address of applicant
- 2. Scientific and common names of species
- 3. Description of overall structure of operation
- 4. Description of breeding facility
- 5. Origin, numbers and dates of captive wild breeding stock
- 6. Number and age (as available) of all breeding stock being raised on the farm
- 7. History of second generation offspring produced
- 8. Breeding records that are available for inspection and scrutiny
