A LAW TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(IMMUNITIES, POWERS AND PRIVILEGES) LAW
(REVISED)
(LAW 24 OF 1965)

ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Legislative Assembly (Immunities, Powers and Privileges) (Amendment) Law, 1985.

Amendment of s. 3 of
Law 24 of 1965

2. Section 3 of the Legislative Assembly (Immunities, Powers and Privileges) Law (Revised) is amended by the addition, immediately before the end thereof, of the following words - “nor shall any such proceedings be instituted against any person in respect of such words broadcast or re-broadcast by any broadcasting station licensed under the Broadcasting Law, 1977, or wholly owned by the Government of the Cayman Islands”.
