**WATER AUTHORITY LAW, 1982 (LAW 10 OF 1982)
WATER AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1987**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 60 of the Water Authority Law, 1982 and after consultation with the Water Authority, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Authority (Amendment) Regulations, 1987.

Substitution of reg. 5.

2. Regulation 5 of the Water Authority Regulations, 1985, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, is substituted by the following -

“Duration of Licence of Right. 5. Licences of right shall be of indefinite duration, beginning from the date of issue.”.

Substitution of reg. 8

3. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is substituted by the following -

“Duration of Licences. 8. A licence to abstract groundwater shall be of indefinite duration, beginning from the date of issue.”.

Amendment of reg. 16.

4. Regulation 16 of the principal Regulations is amended by -

- (a) substituting “an indefinite duration” for “one year” in the first line of paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1);
- (b) inserting “discharge into ground water into or onto the ground and into territorial waters and for the” immediately after “the” in the second line of sub-regulation (2);
- (c) substituting “17A” for “5” in the third line of sub regulation (2).

5. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting the following new regulation immediately after regulation 17 -

“Renewal of permits. 17A. (1) Permits granted under paragraphs (b) and (c) of sub-regulation (1) of

regulation 16 may be renewed at the discretion of the Authority upon a written request to be filed with them not later than two months prior to expiration.

(2) Such requests shall be accompanied by the appropriate renewal fee prescribed in Schedule 2. Failure of the permit holder to file for the renewal of his permit within this period will result in the relevant application being entertained by the Authority as though it was an application for a new permit or, if no application has been filed prior to the expiration of the permit, in its termination. The Authority is entitled to issue expiration date reminder notices to permit holders.

(3) Upon receiving an application for the renewal of a permit, the Authority shall notify the applicant in writing that the application -

- (a) has been approved;
- (b) has been approved, subject to the permit being varied by -
 - (i) the amendment of any one or more of the terms or conditions;
 - (ii) the revocation of any one or more of the terms or conditions;
 - (iii) the addition of one or more terms or conditions;
 or
- (c) has not been approved.”.

6. Regulation 28 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting “17A” for “5” in the third line of sub-regulation (5).

7. Schedule 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting -

- (a) “per annum” from the last lines of -
 - (a) paragraph (a) of item 1;

- (b) paragraph (b) of item 1;
- (c) paragraph (c) of item 1;
- (d) paragraph (d) of item 1;
- (e) paragraph (e) of item 1;
- (f) paragraph (f) of item 1;
- (g) paragraph (a) of item 2;
- (h) paragraph (b) of item 2;
- (i) paragraph (c) of item 2;
- (j) paragraph (d) of item 2;
- (k) paragraph (e) of item 2;
- (l) paragraph (f) of item 2;

- (b) paragraph (g) of item 1;
- (c) paragraph (g) of item 2;
