In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Public Health Law, 1981, the following Notice is hereby made -

Citation.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment of Schedule) Notice, 1988.

Amendment of  
Schedule.

2. The Schedule to the Public Health Law, 1981 is amended by substituting the following for paragraph 1 -
