In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 21 of the Electricity Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity (Amendment) Regulations, 1986.

Amendment of reg. 61.

2. Regulation 61 of the Electricity Regulations, 1977 is amended by substituting a colon for the fullstop at the end of sub-regulation (4) and by adding the following proviso immediately thereafter -

“Provided that, notwithstanding sub-regulation (5), no person who does not possess, or is not the spouse of a person possessing, Caymanian status shall be eligible to take the Electricians Trade Test unless he furnishes documentary evidence that he already possesses a licence which, in the opinion of the Board, has been issued outside the Islands by a body requiring equivalent standards.”.
