In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 21 of the Electricity Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity (Amendment) Regulations, 1987.

Amendment of reg. 61.

Regulation 61 of the Electricity Regulations, 1977 is amended by substituting the following for the proviso to sub-regulation (4):

"Provided that, notwithstanding sub-regulation (5), no person who does not possess Caymanian Status shall be eligible to take the Electricians Trade Test unless he furnishes documentary evidence that he already possesses a licence which, in the opinion of the Board, has been issued outside the Islands by a body requiring equivalent standards to those required in the Cayman Islands".
