

- (d) Air-gun, air rifle and air pistol \$100 per annum.

B- Permits

- (a) Import Permit-
  - (i) for re-importation of firearms licensed in the Islands and used by persons taking part in shooting competitions \$10
  - (ii) for importation by farmers of rifles not exceeding .22 calibre and shotguns Nil
  - (iii) for importation of firearms otherwise than in accordance with (i) or (ii) \$500
  - (iv) for importation of ammunition \$10
- (b) Export Permit \$10
- (c) Transfer Permit
  - (i) Farmers Nil
  - (ii) All other users \$100
- (d) Disposal Permit Nil.

2. For the purpose of these Regulations “farmer” means a person who satisfies the appropriate authority that he farms or manages land that is used for arable purposes or the rearing of stock.

In accordance with the powers conferred by section 39 of the Firearms Law (1995 Revision) the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1998.
