## The Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised)

## The Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement (Commonwealth of Australia) Order, 1990.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3(1) of the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised) the following Order is hereby made -

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement (Commonwealth of Australia) Order, 1990.

Application.

- 2. Part 1 of the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised) shall apply to the Commonwealth of Australia and to judgements obtained in the following Superior Courts of that Country -
  - (a) The High Court of Australia;
  - (b) The Federal Court of Australia; and
  - (c) The Family Court of Australia.
