Part 1 of the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised) shall apply to the Commonwealth of Australia and to judgements obtained in the following Superior Courts of that Country - <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) The High Court of Australia;(b) The Federal Court of Australia; and(c) The Family Court of Australia. |
