The Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised)

The Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement (the Australian Antarctic Territory; the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory in the Commonwealth of Australia) Order, 1990.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3(1) of the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised) the following Order is hereby made -

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement (Australian Territories) Order, 1990.

Application.

2. Part 1 of the Foreign Judgements Reciprocal Enforcement Law (Revised) shall apply to the following Territories in the Commonwealth of Australia and to judgements obtained in the following Superior Courts of those Territories -
