## THE HEALTH PRACTITIONERS (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1993

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 14 of the Health Practitioners' Law 1974, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:-

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Practitioners (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall come into force on 22nd December 1993.

Interpretation

2. The Health Practitioners' (Fees) Regulations, 1975 are amended by revoking regulations 3 and 4 and substituting the following —

"Registration and Application Fees 3. (1) The registration fees required to be tendered by applicants under section 7(2) are —

(a) applications to \$500 practise medicine or dentistry (general practice)

(b) applications to practise medicine or dentistry (specialists)
