HEALTH PRACTITIONERS (FEES) REGULATIONS

(1995 Revision)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Practitioners (Fees) Regulations (1995 Revision).

Citation
2. (1) The registration fees required to be tendered by applicants under section 7(2) are-

Registration and application fees

(a) applications to practise medicine or dentistry (general practice)

\$500

(b) applications to practise medicine or dentistry (specialists)

\$500 (in addition to any other fee)

(c) applications to practise optometry or pharmacy

\$500

(d) applications to practise chiropractic or osteopathy

\$500

(e) applications for registration in respect of any other health profession

\$250

(f) in addition to any fee payable under (a) to (e), an application for registration, or amendment to a registration, in respect of an authorisation to carry out clinical trials

\$1,000, or such larger fee as the Governor in Council may direct shall be payable in respect of the application

(g) applications for amendments to a registration (other than in respect of an authorisation to carry out clinical trials)

\$100

(2) In addition to the registration fees prescribed in subregulation (1), each applicant for registration shall tender an application fee of \$100.
