THE HEALTH SERVICES LAW THE HEALTH SERVICES (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1985

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 7 of the Health Services Law, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985.
- Amendment of reg. 5.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the Health Services (Fees) Regulations, 1975, in these Regulation referred to as the principal Regulations, is amended by deleting ", except for consultation by appointment".

Substitution of reg. 6.

3. Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is substituted by the following -

"Ante-natal 6. All ante-natal services for persons services free. normally resident in the Islands, comprising clinics, blood-testing and drugs necessitated pregnancy (but excluding radiological and ultrasound examinations and teleradiology) shall be free of charge."

Insertion of new reg. 6A.

4. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting the following new regulation immediately after regulation 6 -

Contraceptive 6A. All contraceptive services, including services free. clinics, devices and drugs shall be free of charge, with the exception of such intra-uterine devices as may be specified by the C.M.O.".
