**A LAW PRESCRIBING FEES
FOR SERVICES PROVIDED AT
GOVERNMENT HEALTH CARE FACILITIES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Health Services (Fees) Law, 1993.

Commencement.

2. This Law comes into operation on the date appointed under section 2 of the Health Services Authority (Dissolution) Law, 1993.

Interpretation.

3. In this Law-

"Caymanian" means a person possessing Caymanian status for the purpose of the Immigration Law;

"health care facilities" means the George Town Hospital in Grand Cayman, the Faith Hospital in Cayman Brac, and any other public

health facility or public hospital established or operated in the Islands by the Government.

Fees payable by patients of the health care facilities.

4. (1) Except as otherwise provided by this Law, the fees specified in the Schedule are payable by patients of the health care facilities.

(2) Where a patient is provided with a service specified in Part 2 (Inclusive Fees - Minor and Intermediate Surgical Cases) or Part 3 (Inclusive Fees- Major Cases) of the Schedule the patient will be charged the fee specified in that Part but will otherwise be charged the individual itemised fee or fees specified in Part 1 of the Schedule.

Residents of Cayman Brac and Little Cayman.

5. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a Caymanian ordinarily resident in Cayman Brac or Little Cayman who is a patient at the Faith Hospital in Cayman Brac is liable to pay fees at half the rate specified in the Schedule.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply in respect of a person who is covered by health care insurance which would otherwise cover the whole cost of any service provided at the Faith Hospital.

School children.

6. Subject to section 11, fees are not payable in respect of a patient at a health care facility if the patient is a Caymanian who has not obtained the upper limit of school age (as defined in the Education Law, 1983).

Antenatal services.

7. Subject to section 11, fees are not payable for ante-natal services provided at a health care facility to a Caymanian who is ordinarily resident in the Islands.

Contraceptive services.

8. Subject to section 11, fees are not payable for contraceptive services (including clinics, devices and drugs) provided at a health care facility to a Caymanian who is ordinarily resident in the Islands.

Poor people.

9. Fees payable by a patient at a health care facility may be waived, in whole or in part, if the patient satisfies the Government that he is unable to pay all or any part of the fees.

Free treatment.

10. Subject to section 11, fees are not payable by a patient at a health care facility if the patient presents a card issued, or recognised by the Government identifying the patient to be -

- (a) a public officer or the spouse or a dependant of a public officer (but only to the extent provided in the terms of employment of the public officer); or
- (b) a member of the Veterans Association of the Cayman Islands or the spouse of such a member; or
- (c) a veteran member of the Seamen's and Veterans' Association of Cayman Brac or the spouse of such a

NOTES:

- (1) The fee for a service specified in this Part covers -
 - (a) the surgeon's fees; and
 - (b) use of the operating theatre.
- (2) It does not cover -
 - (a) hospitalization; or
 - (b) biopsy changes; or
 - (c) the cost of any drugs, medicines or any prosthesis or other implants; or
 - (d) anaesthesia charges which will be charged at the rate of \$100 plus \$50 for each half hour or part of a half hour after the first hour.
- (3) If a doctor's or surgeon's assistant is provided an additional fee of \$50 for each hour or part of an hour during which he is provided will be charged.

Exemption not to apply in certain circumstances.

Offence.

member; or

(d) a person receiving a pension from the Government or the spouse of such a person; or

(e) a patient who is being investigated or treated for AIDS, tuberculosis or malaria if so certified by the Medical Officer of Health.

11. The exemptions from fees provided for by sections 6, 7, 8 and 10(b),(c) and (e) do not apply in respect of a person who is covered by health care insurance which would otherwise cover those fees.

12. A person must not supply false or misleading information when applying for an exemption or rebate of fees otherwise payable under this Law.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months
